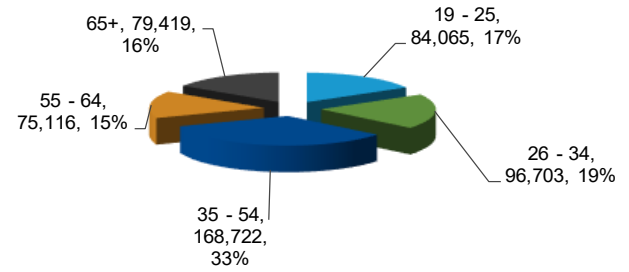

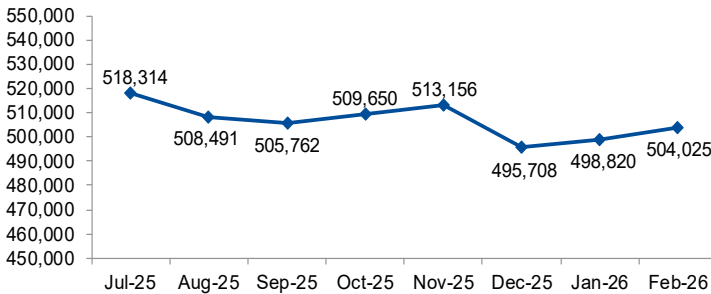

## Adult Enrollment Trend

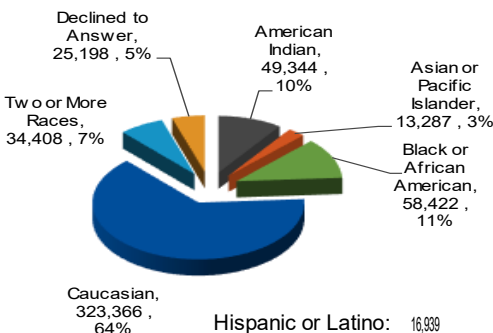
