

- review and approval of PARs.


Dental has a part time Orthodontic Specialist to review all requests for orthodontic services.



Attracting Providers

- Prior to the ending of HMO contracts,
- > approximately 460 dentists in the network
- > less than 120 were actively accepting patients.
- > SFY2012 we had contracts with over 1,200 of our 2,010 in State dentists [60%],
- > and over 240 out of state dentists.
- The majority of participating dentists currently accept new SoonerCare patients into their practice.

OHCA's Varnish Program

- ✓ Tooth decay is the most common chronic disease among children.
- ✓ Children in Medicaid had nearly twice the rate of untreated tooth decay as children with private insurance.
- ✓ Preventive oral health care is particularly important for young children.
- ✓ Presence of cavity-causing bacteria can quickly progress into extensive decay known as Early Childhood Caries (ECC) or baby bottle tooth decay.



North Carolina's Varnish Outcomes

- Increases access to preventive services
 - Wide geographic distribution
 - 48% of well-child visits
 - Physician visits 4 times greater than dentists
 - Multiple visits 20 times greater in medical offices

- Improved treatment outcomes
 - 49% reduction before 18 months
 - 18% reduction at 6 years with >4 visits
 - 21% reduction in hospital episodes
- Began as pilot in 1997
- Statewide rollout in2000








Health Professional Shortage Areas - Dental Care







