
Tax Filing Status

 - Modified Adjusted Gross Income
- Tax Filer
 - Single
 - Married Filing Jointly
 - Married Filing Separately
 - Head of Household
 - Qualifying Widow with Dependent Children
- Dependent
- Non-Filer


Married – Filing Jointly

Married - Filing Separately








