



Adult Medicaid Quality Grant (AMQG)



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- Background
 - \$112 million for collection and reporting of data (2012)
 - -2014)
 - Adult Medicaid Quality Grant (AMQG)
 - \$56 million
 - 56 grant awards were available
 - 26 grants were awarded
 - \$1 million for each 12-month budget period
 - Estimated \$2 million per grantee
 - OHCA awarded \$992,884 (2012-2013)



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Grant Project: Three Aims

- 1. Evaluate methods for collection and reporting of the Medicaid Adult Core Set measures within varying delivery care settings (e.g. managed care, fee-for-service, long term care settings such as nursing homes and intermediate care facilities).
- 2. Develop staff capacity to report the data, analyze, and use the data for monitoring and improving access and the quality of care in Medicaid.
- 3. Conduct at least two Medicaid quality improvement projects (QIPs) relating to Medicaid Adult Core Set measures.
