






#### Race Breakdown of ESI Members



It is available to Oklahomans who are not qualified for an employer-sponsored health plan and work for an Oklahoma small business with 99 or fewer full time employees; temporarily unemployed adults who are eligible to receive unemployment benefits through the Oklahoman Employment Security Commission; or working adults with a disability who work for any size employer and have a "ticket to work". 


#### Race Breakdown of IP Members


