In 2023, Oklahoma Legislature passed SB 32X to advance the ability for systems to exchange health information and create more complete patient health records.


Connection Fee Assistance:

\$30 million legislative appropriation provided for one-time HIE connection fees through 6/30/2024. Funding is not guaranteed beyond this date.

Any Organization that employs licensed Health Care providers in the State of Oklahoma is eligible to receive assistance.

Getting Connected:

- **Step 1:** Apply to participate in Oklahoma's health information exchange.
- Step 2: Complete an application through the office of the State Coordinator to receive assistance with one-time connection fee costs. Subscription fees not included.
- **Step 3:** Receive approval from the Office of the State Coordinator.
