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The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) contracted with one plan to deliver medical services to SoonerSelect children and youth served by Oklahoma Human Services' Child Welfare Services. This includes children in foster care and former foster care children, those receiving adoption assistance, and those involved in the juvenile justice system. The health plan is required to provide the same set of core medical services that are provided to SoonerCare members today. It also offers extra services, called value-added benefits. The chart below shows the value-added benefits it offers. They may help you determine which health plan will best meet your needs.

Members will also be connected to available programs, social services and covered benefits.

After-school Programs

Members ages 6-18 can get up to \$125 per year for Boys and Girls Clubs membership to help them develop social and leadership skills.

In partnership with the Oklahoma FFA Foundation, FFA scholarships are provided to high school students to support skills growth for those interested in agricultural careers.
