

- 1.7 million washable cloth masks
 - (2 per teacher, staff and student)
- 42,000 clear face shields
- 1.2 million pairs disposable gloves
- 1.2 million disposable gowns



- A business
- Public building
- Other indoor place open to the public

It is recommended *all* school teachers and other essential school personnel wear a face covering over the nose and mouth.



District Mask Requirement


➤ **64.6% Yes**

- There is a mandate that the entirety or a portion of the students or staff are required to wear a mask.

➤ **35.4% No**

District Reopenings




➤ **69.6%** All Virtual Option

- The district has students being served through a fully virtual option

➤ **7.5%** Virtual Only

- The district has students being served **only** virtually

Based on an informal survey of districts.




District Reopenings

- **75.5% In person**
 - The district has students being served fully in person
- **24.5%**
 - The district does not offer a full in-person option

Based on an informal survey of districts.


District Reopenings




- **44.4% Blended**
