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Procedures for Identifying EL's

The state provided Edmentum's Exact Path to determine which skills students are missing in relation to their expected grade level. We use Renaissance STAR reading and math to assess students each nine weeks. STAR also provides tests in Spanish, we use this test to help us identify if the gap is due to a language barrier or missing standards. The test is uploaded to exact path which determines a plan for each student based on missing OAS standards in reading and math. In grades K-8 we assign students to an ELL course to provide extra help to students who have been identified as EL. These students have access to curriculum the district has purchased specifically for EL students. Students in grades 9-12 are assigned to advocacy classes with the EL teacher who monitors and supports the students using the curriculum the district has purchased.

We still follow the regular process for identifying EL students as defined in our Title III procedures.
