SUBJECT: Deregulation for Library Media Services

The following school is requesting deregulation for the 2021-2022 school year in order to provide library services to their students by an alternative means. Approval is recommended.

Map of Oklahoma showing Congressional Districts 1 through 5. The map includes county names and a legend for the districts.

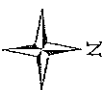
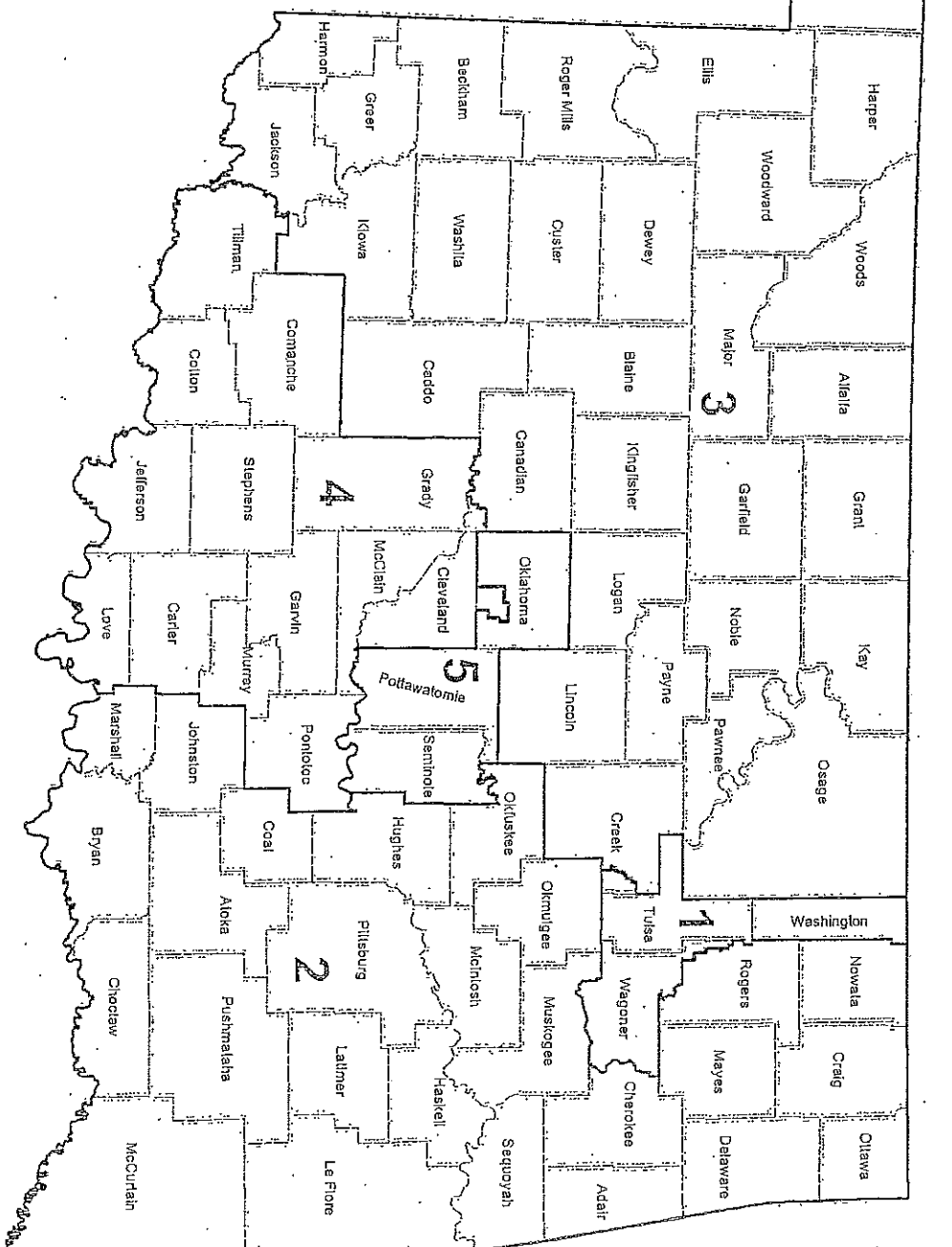

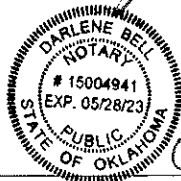

District does not have the financial resources or need to employ a full time librarian at this time. We do have volunteers that maintain the library at this time and it is open to all students daily.

The district has one library site shared by both elementary and secondary students. It will remain open to all students every school day. Funds saved by not employing a librarian will be utilized to direct classroom instruction.

Due to the burden that the pandemic has put on schools this year, positive educational benefits have evolved so that we were able to invest in one-to-one computers/laptops for student use with on-line library resource access.

If the waiver was denied, we would have to reduce classroom staff to be able to pay a library media specialist salary. This would have a negative effect on classroom size and quality instruction.

- C. Has this deregulation been awarded before? If so what was the educational impact to the district: Results of the Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district. If not what do you expect?

Yes it has been awarded before. Funds have been used to serve all students through advanced technology library resources.

Deregulation is requested for the 2021-2022 school year.

- A. Reason for the Deregulation request. Please include circumstances which necessitate changing the standard of library services for your size of school, what alternative means will have to be employed if your waiver was to be denied?

As the District has managed the past few years at that time due to the uncertainty of funds and due to the present circumstances due to COVID-19, the district finds it not feasible to employ a full time library media specialist; therefore, the district will continue to fill the position with an existing employee with a Library Certification with two hours per day and continue to staff a full time library assistant specifically at the Elementary site. The Elementary will be open full day and the MS and HS sites will be open a portion of each day to ensure students have access for the purpose of research and other materials available.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

The Library will be staffed for two hours a day with a certified library media specialist. The remainder of each day will be staffed with a full time library assistant in both the Elementary and Secondary libraries a portion each day. Library access will be allowed by each individual classroom teacher having the ability to check our materials for students as needed. The educational benefits to the students will be the schools ability to purchase textbooks, curriculum materials and the increased accessible technology available with the funds begin saved by operating our libraries with a part-time librarian and full time assistant.

- C. Has this deregulation been awarded before? If so what was the educational impact to the district: Results of the Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district. If not what do you expect?

There has been no negative impact on our students learning. The circulation statistic will be monitored to ensure no drop off in our students access to the library. Students will still have full access to the library as needed.

The Library will be opened each day we are in session for instruction.

The financial impact will only be positive since the funds will allow the district to purchase upgraded materials and technology equipment to service the students.

At each sites staff meeting, a survey will be conducted to ensure that teachers and students have the necessary access to materials, technology and library space for instructional use; however, the cirriculum records will be reviewed to ensure students access to the library has been maintained.

Ms. Ashley Swart, certified Library Media Specialist, will serve full time at the elementary site. The elementary library also has a full time assistant. Therefore, Ms. Swart can assist at the middle school site as necessary throughout the school year.

All library services will remain the same as in the past. The library will remain open throughout the school day. Performance levels will remain consistent with no lapse in library services.

To Whom It May Concern:

Elgin Public Schools is requesting a School Site Deregulation for the school year 2021-2022. Like many school districts, we are stretching every dollar while still providing a quality education to our students. Granting this request will enable Elgin Public Schools to provide library services to our students with our current Library Media Specialist staff.

Our High School Library Media Specialist will be in the Middle School library half day and the High School library the other half of the day. We have not seen any impact on the performance of our students nor do we anticipate any negative affects. Someone is able to open the library anytime that it is needed to check out books.

- A. Reason for the Deregulation request. Please include circumstances which necessitate changing the standard of library services for your size of school, what alternative means will have to be employed if your waiver was to be denied?

Mill Creek School is requesting a deregulation for OAC 210:35-5-71 elementary library and 210:35-9-71 high school library services due to the retirement of our long time library media specialist/English teacher two years ago. We had an in house staff member that had an English degree and that allowed us to save some money and not have to hunt a library position as we were going to have to let some staff go if retirements had not occurred. We simply do not have the funding to fill this position at this point. I have gathered interest on current staff to see who might be willing to start on this certification. I am in hopes that we will have someone soon. If the waiver is denied I guess our only option is to take the hit as a warning or have a volunteer to help us out.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

Mill Creek school has an aide/part time janitor that will be working and keeping the library open and accessible for all students. They will also be the one responsible for deep cleaning the library and books that are returned in so that we may reduce the risk of covid transfer. This will allow for no disruption in services and the student the same opportunity for the students to check out books and advance in their comprehension skills.

If the waiver is denied and we get a warning on our accreditation status I fear that parents will look to us as being unable to serve our students fully and might cause some transfer issues. We lost so many to covid during this covid that we need our kids in school learning. We would still open the library with an aide but the school will look bad to those on the outside and could hurt our chances of keeping students.

- C. Has this deregulation been awarded before? If so what was the educational impact to the district: Results of the Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district. If not what do you expect?

Yes we received this deregulation last year for the 2020-2021 school year. The plan we had in place worked really well. The deep cleaning efforts by all staff and the desire to want to keep school open allowed us to only have to close down for one week this entire year. The library was open as usual and it allowed for students to work towards their reading goals and we saw gains in so many students to make up for some of the time we did not get to come back to school last spring.

A school calendar for the 2021-22 school year is attached with this paperwork as well as a library schedule.

The district will benefit financially from this waiver due to the fact that we will not have to search and find a replacement and cover the cost of that salary. This was a part time position to us in the past and the teacher fulfilled her other hours as the English teacher. At this point it would require us paying an additional person to keep us in compliance. We are strapped financially this year already so it would be a large relief if we are granted this waiver. The funds would be reallocated to simple operations and to staff that are already in place.

We will check in with our students regularly and make sure they are having access to the books at the levels they need. Our renaissance software and other reading assessments will allow us to track their progress and the amount of words they are reading and the level to which they are comprehending.





We are making this request because we do not have a certified librarian on staff nor any qualified applicants. By granting the deregulation, we will be able to hire a part time certified teacher who has maintained our libraries for the past two school years. If our district is not granted the deregulation, we will have to look at possibly sharing a librarian with neighboring district which would be an added expense to our district.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

We have a part time certified teacher on staff who maintains our library and has also done so at other districts in the past. She works with classes on a daily basis, orders books that are not only on students' grade levels but are also of high interest. She works with classroom teachers to provide incentives for students to read. Since she has been in our district the students are reading more and our students reading levels have grown each year. Her positive attitude about reading and her knowledge of children's literature has made a significant impact on our students. If the waiver is denied, our students would not have her expertise and enthusiasm and we would see the number of books being checked out decrease and the quality of our library would go down.

We have been awarded this deregulation in previous years. This deregulation has been a positive impact on our students because we have a certified teacher that has knowledge of students reading levels and can assist them in checking out grade level appropriate books that are both challenging and interesting. She also takes time to work with classes and individual students to help them become better readers. She is a valuable asset to our district and students performance levels have increased as has their love of reading.

Our part time certified teacher in the library meets with classes weekly. She also works with several students daily.

A. Reason for the waiver/deregulation request (be specific).

Adair Public Schools has two libraries, one that serves grades Pre-K through Fifth Grade and one that serves grades six through twelve. At the present time we employ one full time librarian and two full time library aides. The librarian serves one half day in each library and the aides are in the respective libraries all day. We are requesting this waiver to stay with our current set up.

This deregulation application is for accreditation standard OAC 210:35-5-71, which deals with library staffing. The standard allows a one-half time librarian with a full time library aide for enrollment of 300-499 students. We are just barely over the 500 students mark in enrollment in our elementary and would wish to continue to serve our students with the current structure of our library set up.

B. List alternate strategies/plans which the district/site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement.

Our strategy is to have one full time library aide in each library 100% of the time and to have the librarian in the library one half of the day serve both sites. We have been able to meet the educational needs of our students with this set up for many, many years and feel that this is reflected in the high scores on student achievement tests. It also allows us to put more money directly into the classroom.

C. Educational impact to the district: Results of the Statutory Waiver/Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district.

The educational impact to the district will allow us to remain with the current structure of our library media system. Both the librarian and the two library aides are long time employees who are dedicated to their roles in student academic achievement. Adair traditionally scores high in student performance levels. We have had many Academic All Staters and National Merit Scholars who have graduated while this set up has been in place.

The success of our library media program is one reason our third grade reading scores have been so high. Our accelerated reader program allows the students to blossom and read at grade levels far beyond their current one. The program in place is extremely successful.

The libraries open each day at 8:00 a.m. and remain open until the end of the day when the students leave. They are also open extended hours for tutoring as needed.

E. Any financial impact to the District (positive or negative) for the proposed waiver/deregulation.

The financial impact to the district is huge. The proposed deregulation will allow us, if approved, to not employ another full time librarian. That is a salary we can use for a certified teacher to help us keep class sizes in the elementary as low as possible. Library media expenditures have been waived the last several years but we have maintained our funding and have used several grants to keep our libraries fully functional and up to date, meeting the needs of our students.

Meeting this standard for the low number of students that we exceed the 499 students limit would cost the district between an additional \$40,000 - \$50,000 in fixed cost to hire an additional full time certified librarian. This is an area where there is an extreme shortage of qualified applicants at the present time, so there is a possibility there would not be an applicant to employ. Our two library aides have been with this district for over ten years and bring as much expertise to the position as anyone could.

F. Describe method of assessment or evaluation of effectiveness of the plan.

Assessment and evaluation will be done with data from students' grades, test scores and a certified staff questionnaire as to the effectiveness of the library services. Also parental input as to the effectiveness of the library program will be sought at parent teacher conferences.

(OAC 210:35-5-71 & OAC 210:35-9-71) We will have a Certified Library Media Specialist on staff but with the shortage of quality teachers we feel she would best serve the students of our school district in the classroom teaching reading.

Our Library Media Specialist will oversee all phases of the library including ordering, maintaining books and computer stations, library budget needs and monitoring the full time aide.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

Having a quality teacher in Reading in the lower elementary will only help our students to become better readers and students. We have interviewed applicants for Elementary Teachers and there is a shortage in quality teachers. We plan to continue the search throughout this school year.

Employing a full time aide with assistance from Certified Library Media Specialist allows more students success in reading, better performance on year end testing and continuous access to the library.

Crowder Public Schools desires to implement the deregulation upon approval from the Oklahoma State Board of Education. The district requests the deregulations for three (3) years.

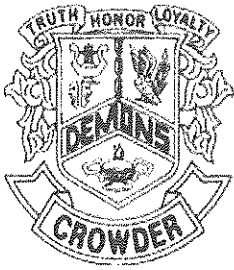

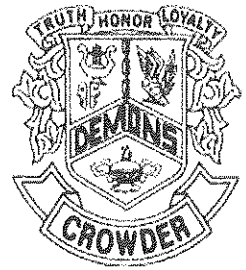

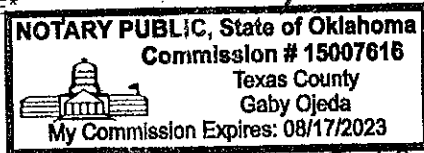

NAME OF WAIVER

- A. Reason for the Deregulation request. Please include circumstances which necessitate changing the standard of library services for your size of school, what alternative means will have to be employed if your waiver was to be denied?

We had a teacher this year who was taking media specialist classes. We were excited to add that as part of her duties, but she took a job back in her hometown and is leaving our district. The district will continue to look for a part time media specialist. We are not changing our services, we will be continuing them. We are a class B, rural school that employs part time teachers for several positions as we can not sustain a full time position due to our need. If the waiver is denied, employing a full time library media specialist would be a financial burden on the district if we could find one.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

Our classroom teachers are adept at the library services needed. We train student aides in check out/in procedures as well as the programs on the computers in the lrc. This is a benefit to all students involved aides learn new skills, younger students get to interact with older students in a positive environment. Our students get the benefit of reading books and taking AR tests, which increases their individual reading levels and should increase their academic achievement. If a library media specialist could be found, the funding for this would be shifted from another needed source, making our tight budget even tighter.

- C. Has this deregulation been awarded before? If so what was the educational impact to the district: Results of the Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district. If not what do you expect?

We have been awarded the deregulation before. We had a teacher this year who was taking media specialist classes. We were excited to add that as part of her duties, but she took a job back in her hometown and is leaving our district. The district will continue to look for a part time media specialist. Our school has operated well with our current services. All students have the opportunity to access the library and some older students access the OPSU library. Elementary students access the library at least once per week, Pre-K - 5. We only have one building for our 2 sites and the lrc is near the middle for all to have easy access. Our performance levels were not affected negatively by the current lrc services. Student aides learn new skills and elementary students have been taught lrc skills.

- D. Timeline: Please submit class schedule, calendars, assessment forms and other attachments as necessary.

The lrc will be open every hour of the school day for student access. Our school day is currently 8:10-3:37. Google survey attached. Over the past years, the teachers and various library aides have worked diligently to organize and make the library into a fully functioning media center. It is well organized and inviting for the students to visit and find a wide variety of books, magazines and other resources to enjoy. By using our experienced teachers and their working knowledge, we are intending to keep our library fully functional and growing. The district has worked very hard to make the library up to date by expanding services and resources now available to our students.

- E. Any financial impact to the District (positive or negative) for the proposed deregulation? If positive please describe where the available would be reallocated.

The primary resources needed will be funds used for any contracted services we utilize through Oklahoma Panhandle State University. The district is currently using the library with the help of classroom teachers. All are experienced and familiar with the library system, check in/check out procedures and already perform these duties when they access the library as well as an instructional aide.

- F. Describe method of assessment or evaluation of effectiveness of the plan both for staff and students, I.E. TLE, ACT scores, graduation rates, RSA, School Report Card, etc.

Teachers, administration, aides, parents and students will be involved in annual evaluation of the library, its needs and services. We will conduct an effectiveness survey in the Spring to allow us to reflect, determine the functionality and effectiveness of the library and make any needed adjustments.


The purpose of this letter is to request a three-year statutory/deregulation for the Goodwell Public Schools Elementary (OAC210:35-5-71) and High School (OAC210:35-9-71) Library Media Services.

Goodwell Public Schools is a class B rural school that has one fully functional library/media area on the campus, along with access to the Oklahoma Panhandle State University library/media collection. The District has a number of aides that will be available to oversee the on-campus library operations. This will be overseen with the help of the classroom teachers, reading interventionist, and administrators. The size, location, and financial position of the district has made it difficult to attract teachers, but a specialized field is even more difficult. We have an outstanding relationship with Oklahoma Panhandle State University through many cooperative agreements. We will continue to use the college's collection to supplement the district's collection and utilize their librarians as consultants. It is our intent to utilize the college librarian staff to teach us how to assure that our public school library has the necessary resources to enable our students the best possible opportunities to succeed.

Our library/media collection will be available to our students everyday that our school is in session as set by the Board of Education in the school calendar. Those hours will be daily from 8 am until 3:30 pm in accordance with the campus bell schedules. Arrangements for students to utilize the OPSU collection will be made by classroom teachers and the administration.
