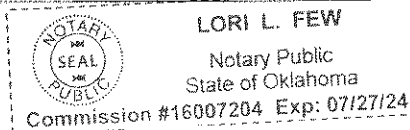

The current plan is for the kindergarten to move to the new building for the 23-24 school year. We would be able to save a part-time librarian's salary.

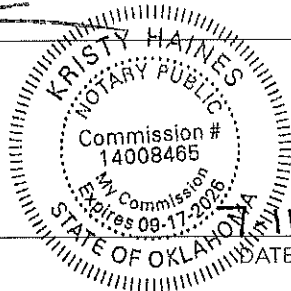

Where is the applicant as it pertains to their pursuit of their course of study? What percentage of your student population will benefit from the waiver if approved?

We are requesting the deregulation for Library Media Services Elementary School OAC210:35-5-71 and Library Media Services Secondary School OAC210:35-9-71 because our LMS retired. She will be returning to work on a part time basis. We will have to hire a full time LMS if our waiver is denied and it is next to impossible to find a LMS in our area of the state.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the district/site proposes. How does this plan best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement? Please list any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

The LMS will be working part time in the library with a full-time library paraprofessional. Our current district enrollment is 582. Certified classroom teachers, classroom paraprofessionals, and student aides will also be working under the LMS direction while students are visiting the library.

- C. Educational impact to the district: Results of the Statutory Waiver/Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district.

Vanoss has received the deregulation in the past. Approval of this deregulation will have a positive impact on our school system because we will be able to operate the library full time under the supervision of an excellent retired LMS. Students will continue to have a positive library experience based on the LMS expertise and the number of qualified personnel to assist in the library while students are using the library.

A copy of our weekly library schedule and hours of operation are attached.

Our district will have a positive financial impact due to the proposed deregulation because the LMS is working part time in the library instead of full time. The additional financial monies will be reallocated to the general fund.

We will monitor the number of books being checked out, Renaissance Learning (Accelerated Reading) points, and the overall satisfaction of the library service/experience through teacher observation and informal surveys.



Where is the applicant as it pertains to their pursuit of their course of study? What percentage of your student population will benefit from the waiver if approved?

Being such a small district of less than 300 students, Pre-K-12th Grade, we have a classroom teacher (who is a certified library media specialist) who monitors the library, across the hallway. The district has made budget decisions to not employ a full time Librarian, but use a Librarian certified teacher as the person who oversees Librarian duties. All of our students benefit because our resources are used to hire certified teachers.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the district/site proposes. How does this plan best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement? Please list any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

Asher Public Schools utilizes the Pioneer Library System as a means of extra opportunities for all students, Students may request to check out books from the Pioneer Library System and have those items delivered to the school site, if the waiver is denied we would have to eliminate a teaching position so we could hire a Librarian Full time.

- C. Educational impact to the district: Results of the Statutory Waiver/Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district.

It would be of great interest to employ a full time Librarian, but due to budget we use a certified teacher on staff to cover the needs, adding an extra duty to her schedule. Our teachers have to be very flexible of Library times, We also have a teachers aide and a volunteer whou helps with the situation at hand.

Our district has a volunteer every Tuesday and a teachers aid to help maintain the Library.

- E. Any financial impact to the District (positive or negative) for the proposed waiver/deregulation? If positive please describe where the available would be reallocated.

The positive, it saves our district a salary, The negative, our students do not have the freedom to attend the supervised Library when they wish. The district is limited on funding to supply books with the Library.

The monies have been reallocated to pay part of our PK-8 Reading Specialist salary.

- F. Describe method of assessment or evaluation of effectiveness of the plan both for staff and students, I.E., TLE, ACT scores, graduation rates, RSA, School Report Card, etc.

The Pioneer Library System has been a big success with our students. They are offered more choices than what Asher Public Schools can offer. The teacher in charge of the Library, spends numerous hours, even on her own time, to maintain the needs of students when it comes to reading. Asher Public Schools will continue to modify times for the needs of students to attend the Library, use the Pioneer Library System and search for other means of meeting reading goals for students.



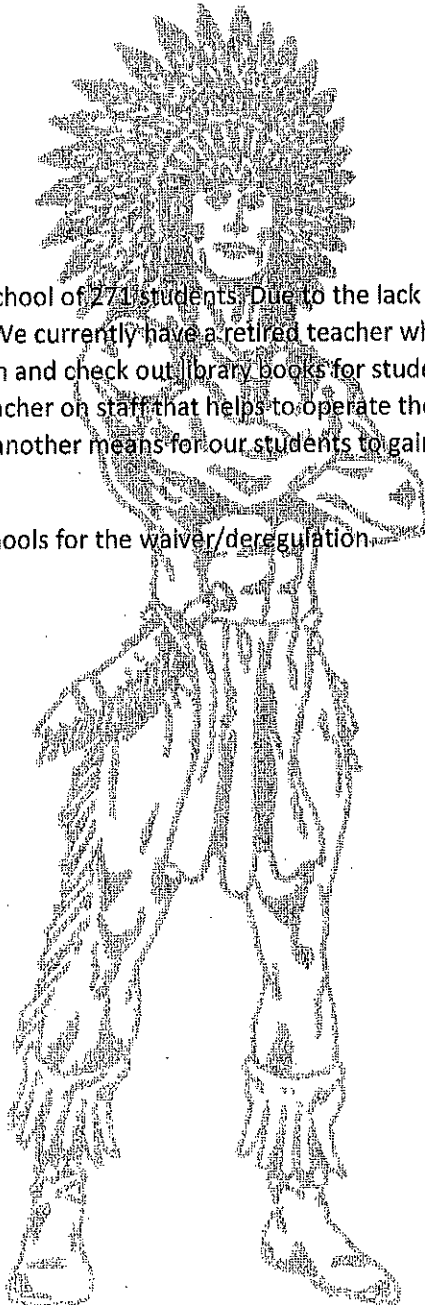

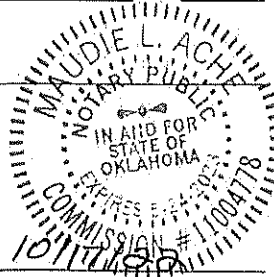

- A. Reason for the Deregulation request. Please include how your students would benefit from this deregulation, what alternative means will have to be employed, and negative effects on your alternative education population if your waiver was to be denied.

Catoosa Public Schools Helen Paul Learning Center is requesting a deregulation from 210:35-5-71 Staffing: The school shall provide staffing for the media program through one half-time library media specialist (librarian) and one full-time library assistant. Helen Paul Learning Center has approximately 878 students enrolled in grades P4-5. The media specialist position has been posted, but we have not been able to fill it with a qualified candidate.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the district/site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your alternative education program, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students, graduation rate if a waiver has been awarded prior to this year, and the result of the previous years alternative education audit.

We have a full-time library assistant that will make periodic presentations to students, will hold classes in the library and teach research skills and check out books and materials when appropriate. The media specialist (librarian) will provide guidance to the library assistant and make periodic presentations to Helen Paul Learning Students. The library will be available to students everyday therefore we do not anticipate any negative change in the educational benefits and learning achievement for students.

- C. Educational impact to the district: Results of the Statutory Waiver, i.e., effect on student performance levels, and predicted graduation rate.

We had a librarian that served the middle and high school libraries. She resigned in July. We found a teacher that was willing to get certified to fill the position, but at the last minute she took a job at another district. We have searched for a replacement, but with the teaching shortage has caused a shortage in all areas. We have hired two full time assistants to stay all day in the library. They are being assisted by the elementary librarian for several hours a week.

We have been unable to find a replacement for the library media position that served half time in the High School and Half time in the middle school. We have previously applied for a waiver while our teacher was completing her degree in Library Media. This year in July she resigned her position to go back into public service. We offered the position to a teacher that had previously worked at our school. She accepted the job and we thought that we were ready to go for the year. However, a short time before school started, she sent a text that she had changed her mind. Another district closer to her home offered her a position so she took it. We have been unable to find a replacement.

We are very upset about the lack of candidates for this position and so have decided to fill the position by putting a para at each site full time and having the principal working with them. We have put a dean of students in the elementary to allow the principal to leave to go assist in the other buildings.

This is most certainly not the best situation, but it is the best that we can do with the current teacher shortage. Thank you for your consideration.

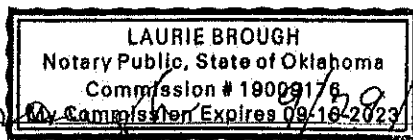

Our extremely small district with a PK-12 student count of 67 has very limited staff. Last year we had a full time media specialist; however, we also had a sudden resignation of our secretary late in the year. With limited financial and human resources, Hardesty Public Schools was forced to have our library media specialist perform her library duties for half the day and cover the secretary vacancy the other half. Hardesty Public Schools presently has no alternative means that could be employed if the waiver is denied.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.

Our district is currently seeking to hire a full time additional staff member to assist in multiple areas including our online classroom and eventually some if not all of the secretary duties thus allowing our media specialist to dedicate her full day to the library.

- C. Has this deregulation been awarded before? If so what was the educational impact to the district: Results of the Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district. If not what do you expect?

This is my first year at Hardesty Public Schools and I am unaware of any previous deregulations or their impact. When checking with OSDE, I did discover that a deregulation has not occurred in the last 3 years. If this deregulation is not approved, we anticipate many difficulties with our day to day operations our secretary is able to support and facilitate that keep our education systems operating to support student learning.

By not having to hire a full time secretary, our district can hire an employee that can assist with our online classes thus allowing our district to regain our accreditation status of approved.

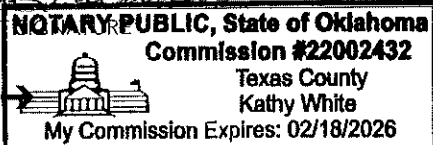

A. Reason for the waiver/deregulation request (be specific).

Optima Public School's Librarian retired this summer, however the district has a long time library assistant that remains on staff. Because of the severe budget cuts in funding and reduction in students our district can only afford a library aide which is highly qualified. Should we encounter difficulties, a retired librarian from a neighboring school has said that she would advise us for \$80 an hour a few days a month. All of our teachers have been trained in our library program software so they , too, will be able to assist in the library.

B. List alternate strategies/plans which the district/site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement.

The district has a full-time highly qualified aide that is assigned full time to the library. By the teachers being trained upon the use of the library software this will enable the library to remain open for the majority of the day even if the aide is absent for a day.

The library is available throughout the day for teachers to bring their classes in for research or to check out books.

C. Educational impact to the district: Results of the Statutory Waiver/Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district.

By allowing this program our district has the ability to provide our students and teachers the opportunity to utilize the library throughout the day. Additional inservice will be made available for the teachers to enable them to utilize the library more effectively. The retired librarian will be available to aide in the use of the resources in the library for test preparation, study skills and lesson plans.

D. Timeline: Please submit class schedule, calendars, assessment forms and other attachments as necessary, or described in instructions.

A waiver/deregulation can be granted for up to 3 years. (Please see instructions for additional requirements)

The library will be in the library from 7:30 am until 4:00 pm each day. All teachers will be trained on the library check in/check out system. Each teacher will have an assigned time to take their students to the library for checking out new books, listening to a lesson on library materials, or stories in the library by teachers and volunteers. Most of the restocking of books will be done by teachers during their planning period.

E. Any financial impact to the District (positive or negative) for the proposed waiver/deregulation.

The deregulation will have a positive financial impact on our district in that we will utilize the current staff and will not have to hire another staff member to function as our librarian. Also, because the retired librarian has volunteered to help train the teachers and aides in the use of the library, we will not have to budget money for additional training.

The district will continue to purchase library books, periodicals, and magazines for the library. We will continue to have a book fair each year. The funds will be used to that were to be allocated for the librarian will be used "to help make ends meets" with our other paraprofessionals. We have been drastically cut over the last several years. We basically receive no state aid. Funds will also be used to purchase materials for our EL students with high interest and lower reading levels. The library will also need new updated technology to run our circulation program. We also need a new projector for the smart board in the library.

F. Describe method of assessment or evaluation of effectiveness of the plan.

As a method of evaluating the effectiveness of the plan, we will track the use of the library. We want to track both the student and teacher use. We want to assess the amount the library is being used and the types of resources being used. We would like to see 100% of both teachers and students using the library. The district would like to see resources used for both educational purposes and as well as books being checked out for personal use. The more students are reading the better their success in all their classes.

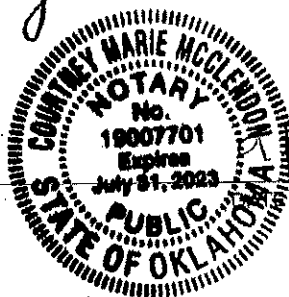

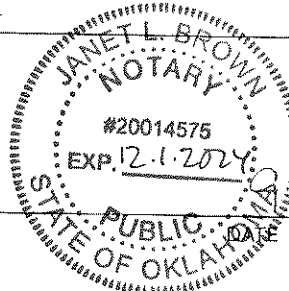

Highland Park will utilize front office staff and parent volunteers in our media center to assist in covering tasks that would be performed by a library assistant. Our media specialist, Mrs. Clayton, makes student literacy a priority and she has implemented a number of strategies to encourage reading for fun, as well as education. So Mrs. Clayton can continue her work, our office staff and volunteers perform duties that were expected of the library assistant. These tasks include assisting students and teachers with book locations, checking books in and out, sanitation of books and equipment, Should the waiver be denied, funding from various programs supporting literacy, RTI, instruction and diverse student needs would likely be pulled to fund the assistant salary.

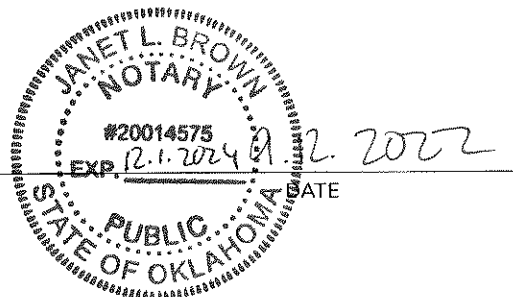

These are jobs and tasks that would otherwise have been performed by a media assistant. Should the waiver be denied, funding from various programs supporting literacy, RTI, instruction and diverse student needs would likely be pulled to fund the assistant salary. These programs are critical to ensuring student success at Aspen Creek.





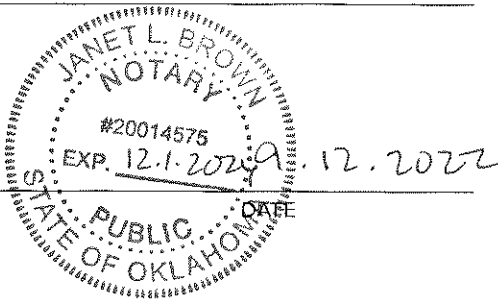

Timber Ridge Elementary strives to meet the needs of our students through a diverse set of instructional experiences. We will continue to serve our students with library media services that enhance student achievement and reading literacy. Timber Ridge will utilize our media specialist, Mrs. Buchanan and a media volunteer in our media center to assist in tasks such as answering phone calls, checking book in and out, returning books to the shelves, managing the front desk, copying and sorting documents, and assisting students with basic questions. These are jobs and tasks that would otherwise have been performed by a media assistant. Should the waiver be denied, funding from various programs supporting literacy, RTI, instruction and diverse student needs would likely be pulled to fund the assistant salary. These programs are critical to ensuring student success at Timber Ridge.

Timber Ridge has requested deregulation in years past due to funding constraints. However, our media specialist is skilled in supplementing classroom reading and literacy instruction. Library media is one of our specialty rotations and we have seen little impact on student performance.
