# STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

## 70 O.S. § 6-187

*Nothing in the Oklahoma Teacher Preparation Act shall restrict the right of the State Board of Education to issue an emergency or provisional certificate, as needed. Provided, however, prior to the issuance of an emergency certificate, the district shall document substantial efforts to employ a teacher who holds a provisional or standard certificate or who is licensed in the teaching profession. In the event a district is unable to hire an individual meeting this criteria, the district shall document efforts to employ an individual with a provisional or standard certificate or with a license in another curricular area with academic preparation in the field of need. Only after these alternatives have been exhausted shall the district be allowed to employ an individual meeting minimum standards as established by the State Board of Education for the issuance of emergency certificates.*

On behalf of Proud to Partner Leadership Academy (PTPLA), I respectfully submit this formal request for a waiver of the financial penalty of \$948.07, associated with Department records indicating that **Proud to Partner Leadership Charter School:**

X Did not lock its submission until **October 20 2025.**

Proud To Partner Leadership Academy experienced a setback as a result of employing a financial management team that did not perform with excellence, which led to the separation of that vendor. At the point of separation, the vendor did not provide an accurate or adequate close out of our OCAS data, which was discovered upon the hiring of a new Treasurer. The new Treasurer served PTPLA for less than a month helping us to sort through records and data, thus finding additional accounting errors and OCAS entries. The amount of work needed for reconciliation was at such a level, that our second Treasurer had to recommend a different vendor/Treasurer with a larger range of services to meet our needs. The new vendor then graciously aligned with PTPLA to become our third Treasurer and financial vendor, thus continuing an expedited and efficient clean up and reporting process for our finances. This process of transitioning through three different financial management groups and treasurers took place between the months of August - October. This also included securing and adjusting the proper bonding information for each of the treasurers. Our current treasurer, who is the third in the hiring timeline, began working diligently to get our OCAS data submitted in its most accurate format, and we were able to submit/lock for

Dear State Board of Education Members,

In accordance with **70 O.S. § 5-135.2(B)**, Krebs Public School respectfully requests a waiver of the penalty associated with locking our 2024–2025 OCAS data on September 3, 2025, two days after the required deadline.

Our district made every effort to meet the September 1 deadline; however, due to circumstances beyond our control, we were unable to complete the lock process by that date. September 1 fell on a holiday, and when I, Patrick Turner, attempted to lock the data on September 2, the “Lock” button did not appear in the system, even though no expenditure or revenue errors were indicated at that time. I checked the system multiple times throughout the day, but the option to lock remained unavailable.

On September 3, Sara Stephens from the State Department of Education contacted our office and identified a data discrepancy preventing the lock. The issue involved a mismatch between Revenue Codes 5120–5190 and 5200 totaling \$42.00. Upon further review, we determined that this discrepancy resulted from the timing of transactions between the Activity Fund and General Fund—specifically, checks issued in June 2025 that were not deposited and recorded in the General Fund until July 2025. This timing difference caused the imbalance in revenue reporting.

Once this issue was identified, we immediately corrected the data and successfully locked our submission on September 3. Copies of the related checks and deposit register are attached for reference.

To prevent future issues of this nature, we have implemented additional internal review procedures to ensure all interfund transactions are fully reconciled prior to the OCAS submission window. We will also coordinate an earlier internal verification process in August to ensure timely completion, even when deadlines fall near holidays.

We respectfully request that the State Board of Education grant this waiver, as the delay was due to system and timing circumstances beyond our control, and every effort was made to comply with statutory requirements as quickly as possible.

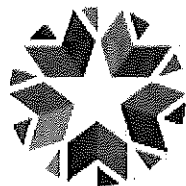

In accordance with **70 O.S. § 5-135.2** and **OAC 210:25-5-4**, every school district is required to transmit a copy of its actual income and expenditure data to the State Department of Education and lock the data **no later than September 1**. This submission must utilize the **Oklahoma Cost Accounting System (OCAS)** functional categories and must be **certified by the district superintendent or head of charter school no later than November 1**.

Failure to meet either of these deadlines is considered *not operating pursuant to the Oklahoma Cost Accounting System* and may result in a reduction of State Aid under **70 O.S. § 5-135.2(B)**.

To Whom it May Concern:

In the matter of Pittsburg Public School narrowly missing the deadline of certifying our OCAS data for the FY 25 academic year and receiving a penalty reduction in State Aid of \$1,064.16, I would like to humbly ask for a waiver of this financial penalty.

There are two main reasons which we feel contributed to this deadline being missed and presented circumstances that were outside of the control of the school district. One, there was a disagreement between our auditors at Patton & Odom and SDE as to what the beginning balance of FY25 in the general fund should have been. Navigating through this data with both parties, as well as our district treasurer who was new to our district in FY25, took some additional time and research to find the source of the data disagreement and properly document the findings to SDE. OCAS data is not able to be certified until it is in agreement.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> main reason is directly related to our investigation of how this issue could occur. It was also discovered that the Pittsburg County Clerk had made a clerical error in reporting the school's financial information to our auditors. Once this was discovered and corrected, that information had to be forwarded to our auditors, corrected by them and a revised Estimate of Needs prepared and forwarded to necessary parties involved.

Discovering this new information in the last half of October proved to be very challenging in regard to communicating and coordinating with several different offices to get information disseminated to the correct people for approval, signatures, documentation and certification; including the Pittsburg County Clerk, Pittsburg County Excise Board, Patton & Odom CPA, the OCAS department at SDE, the Pittsburg Public Schools Treasurer, Sylogist Ed (our accounting software provider) and the Pittsburg Public Schools Superintendent's office.

Efforts are already underway to do our best to prevent a situation like this from happening in the future, including professional development of office staff to better understand the local, county and state approval processes, regular reviews of county financial data to help identify any clerical errors that may occur throughout the school year, as well as more professional development to better understand OCAS accounting processes and reporting.

I am confident that this will not occur again. We are a small, rural school district where we have a small, but talented staff who wear many different hats in our district to give our students the best educational experience we can. This penalty may not seem like a lot to some larger school districts, but it is a very meaningful amount of money that would 100% be used to benefit the students in our district if the Board were to waive this financial penalty; which I humbly request. Any documentation of our communication with these agencies could be provided upon request.

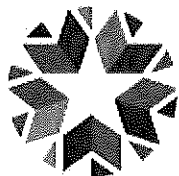

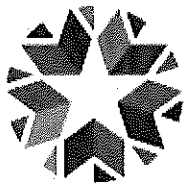

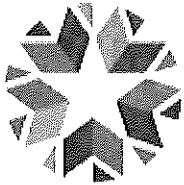
