

WIOA is implemented in Oklahoma in strategic coordination with core partner agencies.



WIOA

- Adults Adults 18 or older and Authorized to work in the US, and one of the following- Veteran/Veteran's Spouse, Low-income, Disability, Homeless/Couch Surfing, Native Americans, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians, Age 55 and older, Ex-offenders, English language learners, Low Literacy Level, Migrant / seasonal farmworker, Single Parents (including single pregnant women), Unemployed 27 or more consecutive weeks, or Displaced homemaker.
- **Dislocated Workers** Eligible to work in the US, **and** Must be eligible to work in the and Recently dislocated / Laid off, Plant closure or substantial layoff, Loss of self-employment income, Displaced homemaker, Military spouse (loss of employment or displaced)
- **Youth** Young Adults 16-24, Pregnant or parenting, justice involved, homeless, aged out of foster care, high school dropouts, disability and/or Limited English Proficiency.
