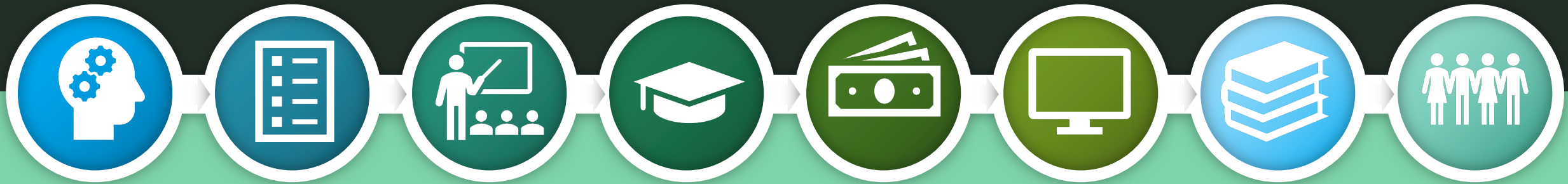

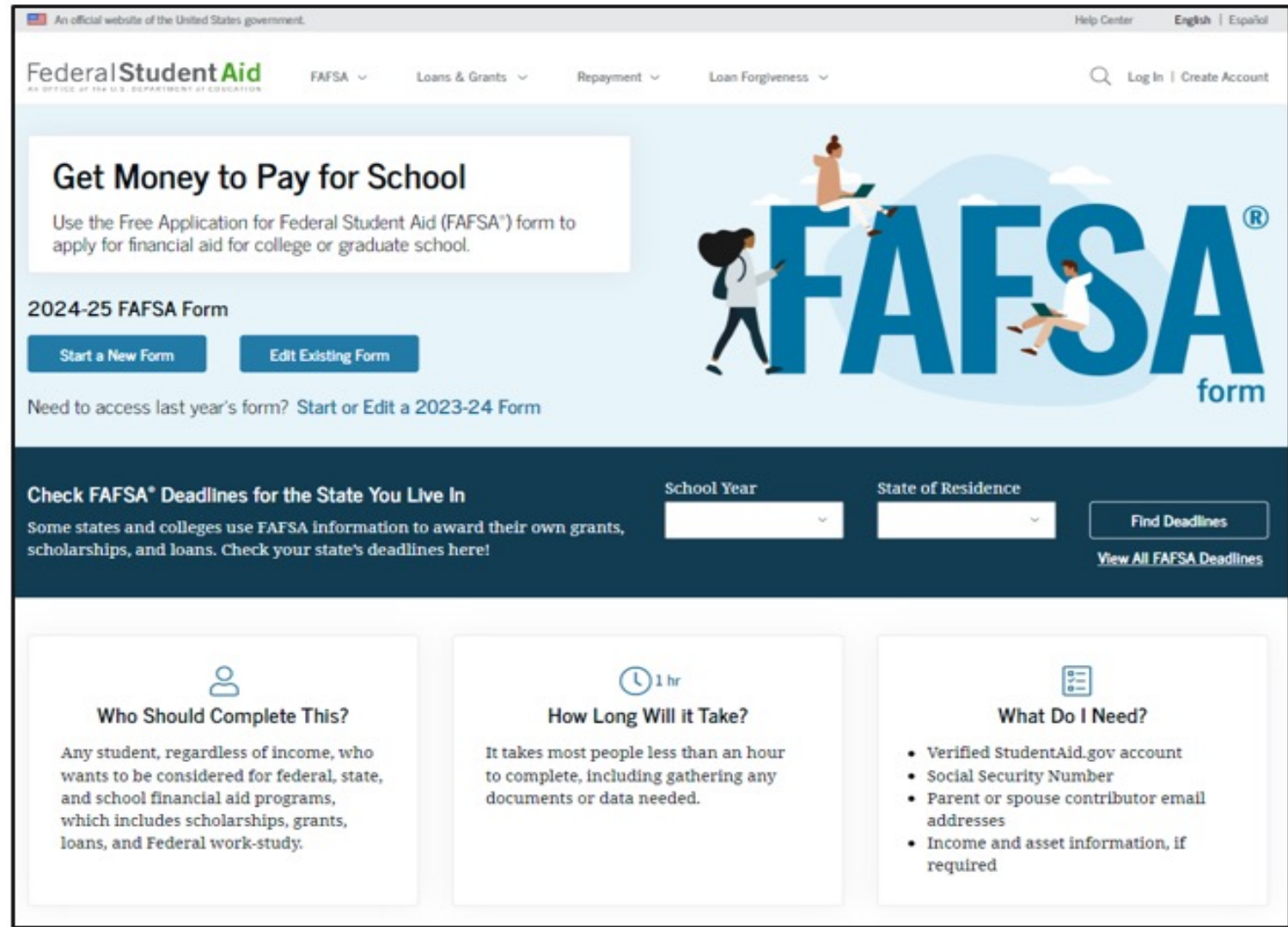

FAFSA

- The FAFSA, or Free Application for Federal Student Aid, is your first step in applying for federal and some state financial aid programs.
- Complete the FAFSA every year for financial assistance to help with college expenses.
- Find the FAFSA application at [FAFSA.gov](https://fafsa.gov).
- To access and sign the FAFSA, students and parents will need to create an FSA ID (Federal Student Aid Identification) at StudentAid.gov.

FAFSA Facts

The high school class of 2022 left about \$3.6 billion in Pell Grants on the table by not completing the FAFSA.

By 2025, nearly three out of four Oklahoma jobs will require education or training beyond high school.

Seniors who complete the FAFSA are 84% more likely to immediately enroll in postsecondary education.

Create an Account (FSA ID)

Username and Password

Username can be 6-30 characters long—a combination of letters and numbers. Not case sensitive.

Because financial aid agreements are legally binding, you can't create an account for someone else, even another family member. Parents and students must create their own accounts.

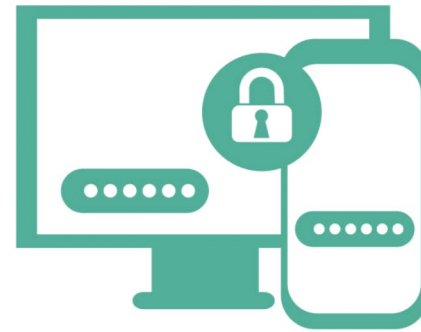

Two Step Authentication

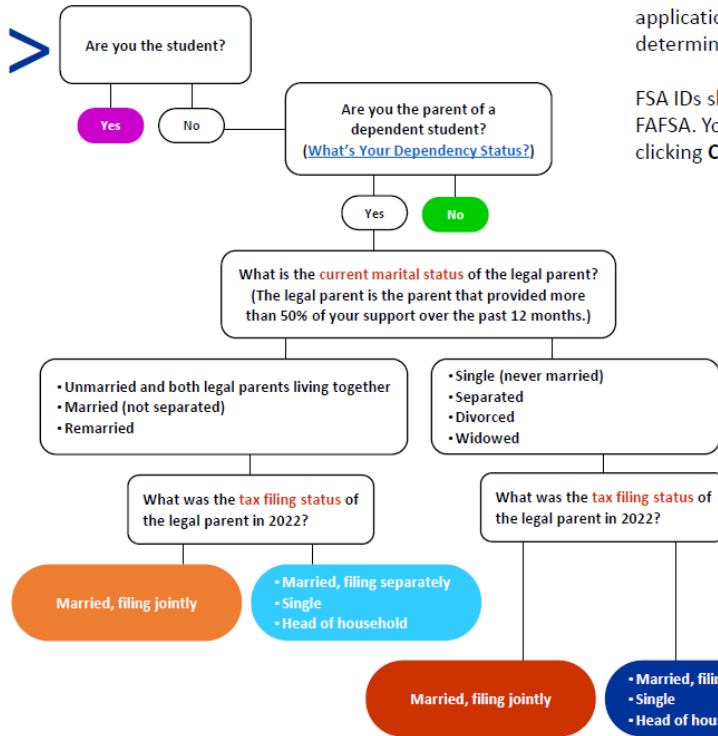
To verify your information you'll need to set up a verification method to utilize two-step authentication. This process was added to secure your entry into the [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) website.

Who needs a Federal Student Aid ID?

For Dependent Students | 2024 – 2025 FAFSA



Federal Student Aid IDs (FSA IDs) are required for students and parents to access and electronically sign the FAFSA. The FAFSA will determine who needs an FSA ID as you advance through the application, but this document is intended to help you determine who needs to create an FSA ID ahead of time.

FSA IDs should be created at least 2-3 days before starting the FAFSA. You can create one today by visiting [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) and clicking **Create Account**.

Every student needs an FSA ID!

Only the legal parent(s) of a dependent student (and their spouse in some cases) will need an FSA ID. Legal guardians will not be contributors to the FAFSA. If a student is determined to be independent for FAFSA purposes, no parents will need an FSA ID.

Only one parent will need an FSA ID to consent to the transfer of 2022 IRS information.

Both parents will need FSA IDs to consent to the transfer of 2022 IRS information.

If currently separated, divorced, or widowed, but 2022 taxes were filed jointly, one parent will need an FSA ID to consent to the transfer of 2022 IRS information. The student should contact the financial aid office to request an income adjustment.

Only the legal parent will need an FSA ID to consent to the transfer of 2022 IRS information.

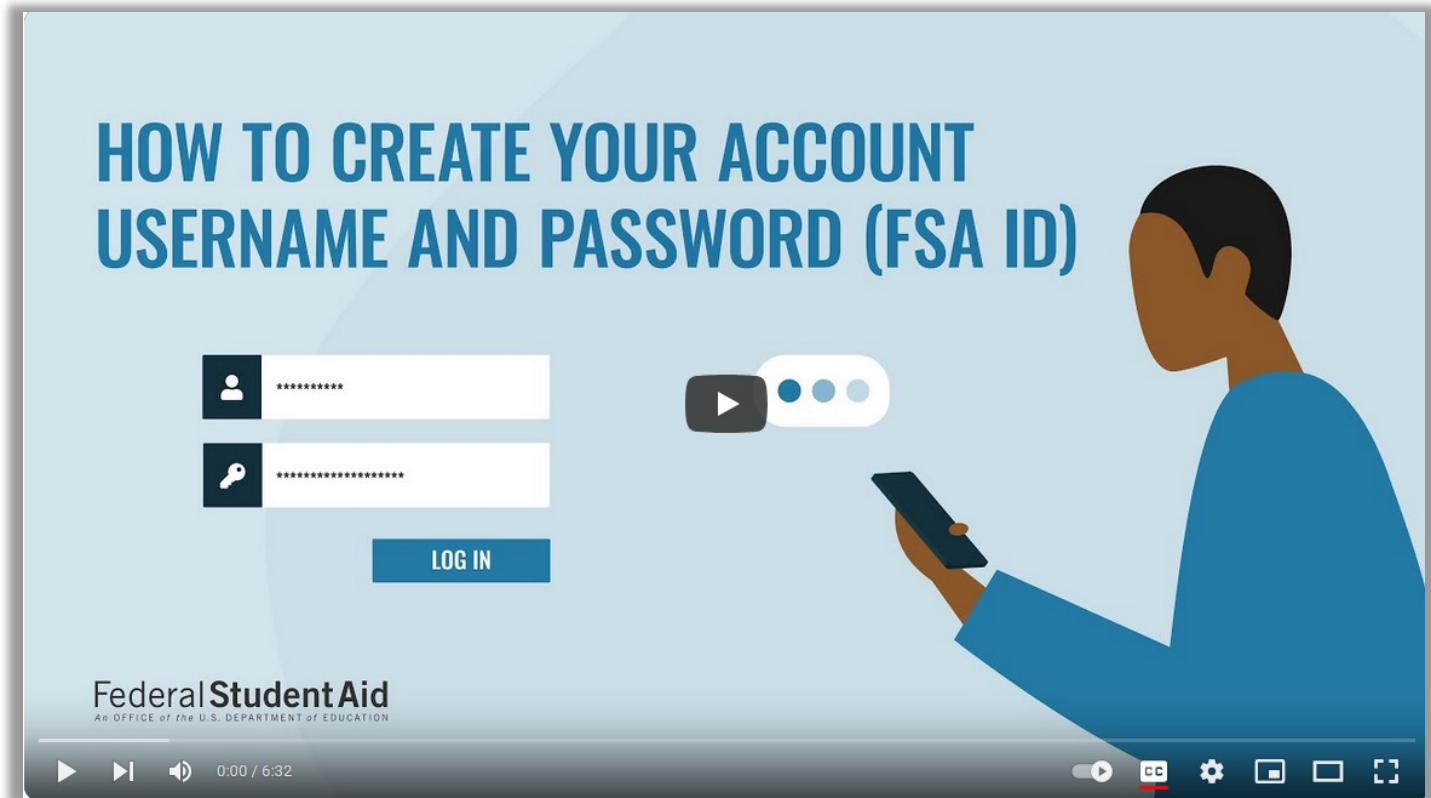
Where Can I Use My FSA ID?

- Confirmation of your FSA ID can take from 1-3 days.
- Once your FSA ID has been confirmed, you can use it to sign your FAFSA and access other Federal Student Aid websites.
 - Complete student loan paperwork and the Master Promissory Note (MPN)
 - Student loan entrance and exit counseling
 - Monitor student loan balances
 - Apply for student loan discharge under certain circumstances



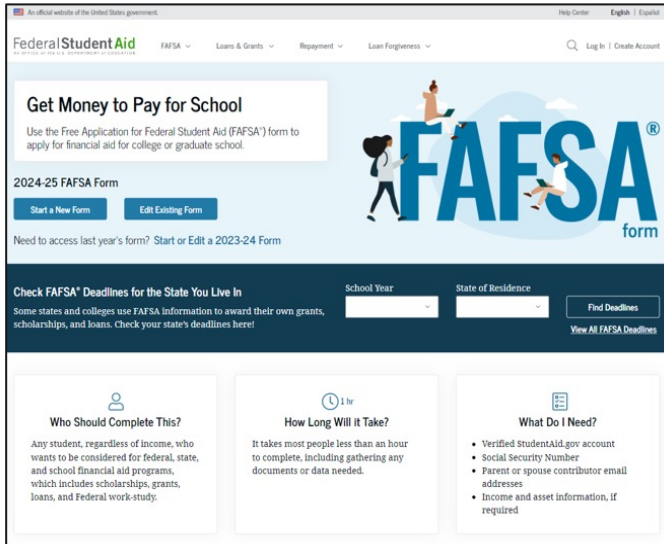
