
# EVENT SUMMARY

The Enid Pages Across the Plains Literacy Workshop successfully hosted **57 attendees, including 42 teachers and 15 administrative leaders**, for a full day of evidence-based literacy professional development. Participant feedback highlighted the workshop's impact, with many praising the depth of learning around dyslexia and the dismantling of 3-cueing practices. Educators especially valued the opportunity for hands-on interaction with classroom-ready manipulatives and tools. The event provided a meaningful space for advancing instructional knowledge and strengthening district-wide alignment around the Science of Reading.
