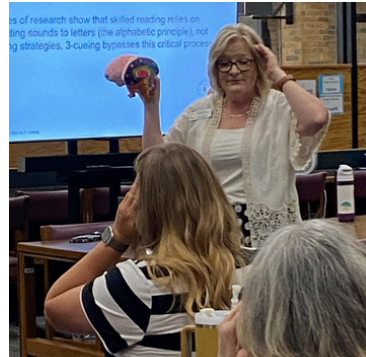


# EVENT SUMMARY

The Woodward Pages Across the Plains Literacy Workshop successfully hosted **50 attendees; including 4 paraprofessionals, 41 teachers, and 5 administrative leaders**, for a full day of evidence-based literacy professional development. Participant feedback emphasized the impact of the session's focus on foundational handwriting instruction, the development of the reading brain, and morphology-based classroom activities. Educators especially appreciated the collaborative atmosphere, with multiple districts from across the northwest region coming together to share insights and align around best practices. The event provided a valuable opportunity to deepen instructional knowledge and reinforce regional coherence around the Science of Reading.
