General Project Description:

The Authority owns and operates a wastewater collection system consisting of clay tile and PVC piping, brick manholes, lift stations, and a wastewater treatment plant (WWTP). Much of this infrastructure is deteriorating due to age. To assess system deficiencies, the Authority conducted a Sanitary Sewer Evaluation Survey (SSES), which identified numerous issues contributing to significant inflow and infiltration (I/I); particularly during wet weather events, placing excessive strain on the lift stations and WWTP, and contributing to unpermitted discharges. The Authority is currently under Administrative Compliance Order (ACO) No. 23-329, issued by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ), for multiple violations. These include unauthorized discharges without a permit, exceedances of permit limits for Biochemical Oxygen Demand over 5 days (BOD5), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), E. coli, and Total Residual Chlorine (TRC); pH levels below minimum permitted limits; and operation and maintenance violations. The proposed project will address the ACO through planning and design for improvements to the WWTP, as well as planning and design for all necessary improvements identified in the SSES, plus all other necessary work to complete the study.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$1,500,000.00, which will be fully funded through Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Loan Forgiveness.

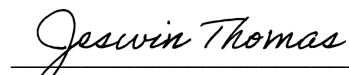
