General Project Description:

The Lexington Public Works Authority (Authority), located in Cleveland County, has a population of 2,010 (United States Census 2020). As of 2025, it services 731 active water connections and 731 sewer connections.

The (Authority) is currently under enforcement with the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) for effluent limitation violations occurring at the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP). This project is to perform a citywide sanitary sewer evaluation survey. The survey results will allow the Authority to assess and identify critical infrastructure deficiencies in the wastewater collection system and develop future capital improvement projects designed to reduce the amount of inflow/infiltration (I/I) entering the collection system and mitigate the violations occurring at the WWTP. The estimated cost is \$1,500,000, which will be fully funded through CWSRF loan forgiveness.
