Dear Mr. Tutkowski:

This is in reference to the Management Plan submitted to OWRB on December 28, 2012, following our December 27, 2012 consultation discussion with OWRB Staff regarding the Site-Specific Water Management and Conservation Plan (Management Plan) for our Troy Quarry (formerly known as "Mill Creek" Quarry).

Please note that the Groundwater Permit (2008-529) was issued by OWRB on April 28, 2020, and the Stream Water Permit (2008-010) was issued by OWRB on May 26, 2020. Please also note that the Mining Permit (L.E.-2689) was issued by ODOM on July 22, 2019, and became a "producing" mine on October 9, 2019, by physically commencing "permitted extraction from natural deposits". No water was used at the facility in Q1 2025.

Please accept this letter as our Interim Quarterly Report pursuant to 82 O.S. 1020.2 (E) and 785:30-15 for Q1 2025 and hereby report the following:

- (1) Troy Quarry was a producing mine in Q1 2025;
- (2) There was NO Pit Water accumulated or used at the Troy Quarry in Q1 2025;
- (3) Troy Quarry adopted the Management Plan prior to January 1, 2013, and has implemented the plan upon becoming a "producing" mine. It is our understanding from the consultation meeting on December 27, 2012, that it will maintain the "exempt mine" status for Troy Quarry.
