To the People of Oklahoma:

I am pleased to issue the fiscal year 2022 annual investment performance report from the Office of the State Treasurer. I trust you will find it thorough and in keeping with my commitment to provide full and complete disclosure of the activities within my office. As always, my staff and I are available to answer any questions you might have.

Market Conditions and Economic Developments

The Federal Reserve kept interest rates targeted between 0% - 0.25% from the beginning of fiscal year (FY) 2022 until March 16 when the Fed increased rates by a quarter percentage point. This action by the Fed reflected the first interest rate increase since 2018. Additional increases to the benchmark federal funds rate occurred in May with a half-percent increase. Then a three-quarter percentage increase was approved in June, bringing the rate to 1.75%. The Fed began a strategy of rate tightening aimed at reducing rising prices pressure and said it would begin shrinking the central bank's \$8.9 trillion asset portfolio as the securities mature.

The treasury curve moved up for all maturities with continued inflation attributing to interest rate increases and higher yields for treasuries. The benchmark 10-year treasury gained 1.55% by June 30, causing a yield of 3.01%. The 2-year treasury increased in yield by 2.70%, and the 30-year treasury returned 3.18% by the end of the fiscal year.

There was much volatility in the stock market at the beginning of the fiscal year, due to concerns regarding the Omicron covid variant and global supply chain issues. Then there were developments related to the Russia-Ukraine war, which began on February 24, such as interest rate increases by the Fed and rising inflation which contributed to negative equity returns. By June 30, the S&P had suffered its worst first half of the year since 1970. The total returns for fiscal year 2022 were -11.9% for the S&P 500, -10.8% for the Dow Jones and -23.9% for the Nasdaq.

The unemployment rate declined from the FY high in July 2021 of 5.9% to 3.6% for April. The labor force participation rate was 62.3% in June, which was still below the pre-pandemic rate of 63.3%. The nonfarm payroll was the highest in August 2021 and the lowest created jobs released in December 2021. There were approximately 6.07 million jobs created during the fiscal year, in comparison to 11.6 million in FY 2021. The underemployment rate, which occurs when a job does not use the worker's skills, is part-time, or leaves the worker idle, was 7.1%, declining from 9.8% during the fiscal year.

The headline consumer price index (CPI) and the producer price index (PPI) during FY 2022 had the largest on record 12-month increases. In July 2021, the CPI year-over-year was 5.4% in comparison to 8.6% in June 2022. The PPI final demand year-over-year was 7% at the start of the FY and was at 10.8% at the end of June. Higher inflation was attributed to a rise in prices, along with increased labor costs. Retail sales were affected at the beginning of the FY by factors such as news of product shortages and climbing prices. Increases in prices for gas and food were reasons why consumers purchased less goods, with the FY average for retail sales month-overmonth being 0.5%. The reported seasonally adjusted rate of existing home sales for each quarter were 5.91 million, 5.72 million, 6.23 million and 5.6 million. Increasing mortgage rates, continued rising home prices and reduced inventory continued to negatively affect recent home sales. The gross domestic product on an annualized

quarter-over-quarter basis was 6.7% for the 2nd quarter of 2021, 2.3% for the 3rd quarter, 6.9% for the last quarter of 2021 and (1.6%) for the 1st quarter of 2022. According to U.S. News & World Report, the economy "downshifted from its torrid pace in 2021 as federal stimulus programs ended and rampant inflation cut into consumer spending and corporate profits."

Portfolio Performance

The yield to maturity at cost for the State Treasurer's portfolio was 1.33% with the weighted average maturity at 1,034 days. The fiscal year 2021 portfolio yield was 1.16%. The total portfolio market value was \$12.6 billion, in comparison to \$10.1 billion as of the previous annual report. No losses were realized due to excellent liquidity and because investments were typically held to maturity.

Portfolio Diversification

The total portfolio contained 29% in agency bonds, 39% in treasuries, 26% mortgage-backed securities and 5% cash on June 30, 2022. Diversification was maintained through a mixture of fixed income securities, such as U.S. treasuries, government sponsored enterprises, mortgage-backed securities, certificates of deposit, state bond issues and foreign bonds. Cash holdings were diversified through the utilization of several government money market mutual funds.

In keeping with the state's statutory investment objectives, the portfolio strategy continued to seek safety, liquidity and return on investment, in that order. Investments were made with a buy-and-hold strategy, while monitoring the duration of the portfolio. The portfolio interest earnings for fiscal year 2022 were \$79.8 million. The investment portfolio's yield will continue to increase significantly due to lower earning bonds maturing and bonds with higher yields being purchased, as a result of the Federal Reserve's strategy of continued interest rate increases.

Collateralization

All funds under the control of this office requiring collateralization were secured at rates ranging from 100% to 110%, depending on the type of investment.

Payments, Fees, and Commissions

Securities were purchased or sold utilizing competitive bidding. Bank fees and money market mutual fund operating expenses are detailed in the attached pages, as is the earnings split between the State Treasurer and the master custodian bank on securities lending income.

Total Funds Invested

Funds available for investment at market value include the State Treasurer's investments at \$9,588,048,895 and State Agency balances in OK Invest at \$3,086,966,404, for a total of \$12,675,015,299.



Office of the State Treasurer Distribution of Assets Under Management June 30, 2022





Office of the State Treasurer Explanation of Performance Comparison June 30, 2022

The following page presents market rates of return on the Securities portion of the General Account and the State's aggregated State Agency Accounts. These figures, which are dollar and time-weighted where appropriate, are calculated using the percentage change in market value (inclusive of accrued income) from the end of the prior fiscal year to the end of the current fiscal year.

To ensure the integrity of data, this information is provided by the Treasurer's custodian bank acting in its capacity as an external third party. As such, performance measurement is presently confined to those investments which are held with the custodian bank Northern Trust Company.

¹⁾ The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Northern Trust Company acting as lending agent. Northern Trust retains 20% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the year was \$106,943. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains the first \$450,000 of security lending revenue in a revolving fund. These funds are used to pay custody and other banking fees. Any revenue not needed for this purpose is deposited to the General Fund.

²⁾ During the year, bank fees of approximately \$380,807 were reported for JP Morgan, however earnings credits were used to satisfy these fees.
