Investment Outlook

June 2026

Portfolio Performance

June portfolio yielded 3.72%, up from 3.70% last year, with a weighted average maturity of 758 days.

Total assets under management of \$17.9 billion, down \$188 million in comparison to June 2025.

Total portfolio contained:

- **67.7%** in U.S. Treasuries,
 - **19.5%** in money market mutual funds,
 - **10.7%** in mortgage-backed securities,
 - **1.0%** in state and foreign bonds,
 - **0.4%** in U.S. government agencies, and
 - **0.7%** in certificates of deposit,
- comprising the balance of funds invested.

Treasury curve flattens further as front-end yields climb

Treasury yields rose across most of the curve in June, again led by the front end and belly, as markets weighed hawkish Federal Reserve communication against signs of a softening labor market.

- 2-year Treasury yield ended the month at 4.18%, up 17.0 basis points from May month-end, while the 5-year yield rose 8.6 basis points to 4.23%.
- 3-month yield rose 14.2 basis points to 3.82%, while the 10-year yield was little changed, up 2.9 basis points to 4.47%.
- 30-year yield edged down 2.0 basis points to 4.95%, the only decline along the curve.
- The 2-year to 10-year spread narrowed further to roughly 29 basis points as short and intermediate maturities led the move higher, extending the flattening trend and reflecting expectations that the Fed will hold rates elevated.

Equities diverge as the Dow gains and tech pulls back

Equity markets diverged in June. The Dow rose 2.52%, while the S&P 500 fell 1.06% and the Nasdaq declined 2.81% for the month.

- The rotation favored cyclical and value names in the Dow, while higher yields and stretched valuations weighed on technology and AI-related shares that had led the prior two months.
- Year to date, the Dow was up 8.85%, the S&P 500 gained 9.55%, and the Nasdaq Composite advanced 12.79% through June month-end.
- The Dow closed the month at 52,319, the S&P 500 at 7,499, and the Nasdaq Composite at 26,214, with all three indices holding solid year-to-date gains.

June minutes show growing inflation concern under Warsh

Minutes of the June 16-17 FOMC meeting, released July 8, showed a few officials saw a case for raising interest rates, though all ultimately supported holding the federal funds rate steady at 3.50% - 3.75% in Chairman Kevin Warsh's first meeting.

- Participants generally assessed that upside risks to price stability remained elevated, while downside risks to achieving maximum employment had moderated somewhat over the intermeeting period.
- Updated projections released after the meeting showed nine officials foresaw at least one quarter-point hike this year, with six anticipating at least two, while another nine expected no move or a cut. Warsh declined to submit a rate forecast.
- In a scenario of moderating inflation, most participants said the Committee would maintain or eventually lower the target range; in a scenario where inflation stayed elevated on strong AI-driven demand, high energy prices, and tariffs, most said some policy firming would likely be warranted.
- The post-meeting statement noted inflation remained elevated and reiterated the Committee's commitment to deliver price stability.

Job growth slows sharply as participation falls

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), nonfarm payroll employment rose by just 57,000 in June, well below expectations, while the unemployment rate ticked down to 4.2%.

- The labor force participation rate fell 0.3 percentage point to 61.5%, the lowest since March 2021, as roughly 720,000 people left the labor force; the number of unemployed people was little changed at 7.1 million.
- Employment continued to trend up in professional and business services +36,000, social assistance +25,000, and health care +22,000, while leisure and hospitality declined by 61,000.
- April payrolls were revised down by 31,000 to +148,000 and May payrolls were revised down by 43,000 to +129,000, a combined downward revision of 74,000.
- Average hourly earnings rose 0.3% month over month to \$37.64 and 3.5% year over year, while the average workweek held at 34.3 hours.

Inflation falls in June as energy prices retreat

The Consumer Price Index decreased 0.4% in June, the largest one-month decline since April 2020, after rising 0.5% in May, according to the BLS. Over the last 12 months, the headline index rose 3.5%, down from 4.2% in May.

- The energy index fell 5.7% over the month, the largest contributor to the decline, more than offsetting increases in shelter and food as gasoline prices posted their biggest drop since 2022.
- The Core CPI, which excludes food and energy, was unchanged over the month and rose 2.6% year over year, down from 2.9% in May.
- The food index rose 0.2% over the month, with both food at home and food away from home up 0.2%.
- Decreases in motor vehicle insurance, communication, apparel, medical care, and used cars and trucks helped offset gains in recreation, household furnishings, and personal care.

Producer prices decline as energy goods drop

The Producer Price Index for final demand fell 0.3% month over month in June after rising 0.6% in May, according to the BLS. On an unadjusted basis, the index increased 5.5% for the 12 months ended in June.

- The decline was driven by prices for final demand goods, which fell 1.4%, the largest decrease since July 2022, as final demand energy dropped 6.4% and final demand foods fell 2.6%.
- Prices for final demand services moved up 0.2%, partly offsetting the decline in goods.
- The index for final demand less foods, energy, and trade services rose 0.1% in June after jumping 0.8% in May, and increased 5.1% year over year.

Retail sales rise modestly as gasoline spending drops

Retail sales rose for a fifth straight month in June. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, advance estimates of retail and food services sales increased 0.2% month over month, in line with expectations, after a revised 1.0% advance in May.

- Seven of 13 retail categories posted gains. Excluding gasoline stations, sales increased 0.7%, while sales excluding autos and gas rose 0.4% and the control group rose 0.5%.
- Gasoline-station receipts fell 5.3%, the sharpest decline since 2022, as average national pump prices dropped roughly 50 cents a gallon during the month.
- Nonstore retailers jumped 1.9%, the biggest increase in nearly a year, likely boosted by Amazon's Prime Day event, while sporting goods, electronics, and appliance stores also rose.
- Motor vehicle and parts dealers climbed the most since July 2025, and spending at restaurants and bars, the only service-sector category in the report, edged up, signaling continued consumer resilience as cheaper gas freed up discretionary spending.

Existing home sales dip as affordability pressures persist

The housing sector softened in June. According to the National Association of Realtors, existing home sales fell 2.4% month over month to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 4.09 million units, though sales were up 2.8% from one year ago.

- Unsold inventory fell 0.6% to 1.56 million units, representing 4.6 months of supply.
- The median existing-home sales price increased 1.8% from one year ago to \$440,600.
- Sales rose month over month in the Northeast but declined in the Midwest, South, and West, as mild fluctuations in mortgage rates continued to sway affordability-sensitive buyers.

Q1 GDP revised up to 2.1% in third estimate

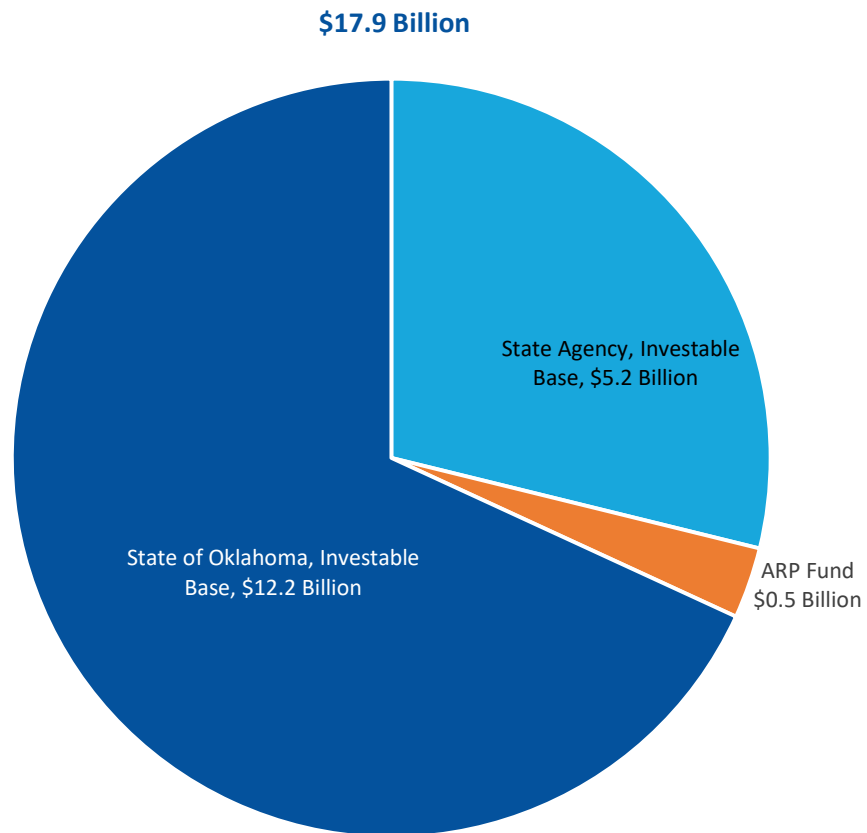
Real GDP increased at an annualized rate of 2.1% in the first quarter of 2026, according to the third estimate released by the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis, an upward revision of 0.5 percentage point from the second estimate and an acceleration from the 0.5% pace recorded in the fourth quarter of 2025.

- The upward revision primarily reflected a downward revision to imports, which are a subtraction in the calculation of GDP, partly offset by a downward revision to consumer spending.
- Real final sales to private domestic purchasers increased 1.7% in the first quarter, revised down 0.7 percentage point from the previous estimate.
- The PCE price index rose 4.6% in the first quarter, revised up 0.1 percentage point, while the PCE price index excluding food and energy rose 4.4%, signaling continued inflationary pressures alongside firmer growth.

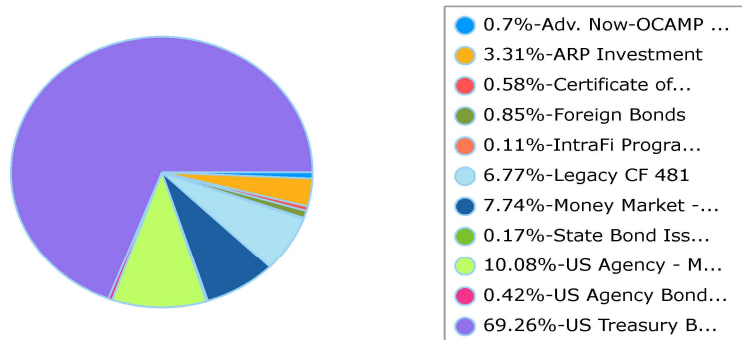

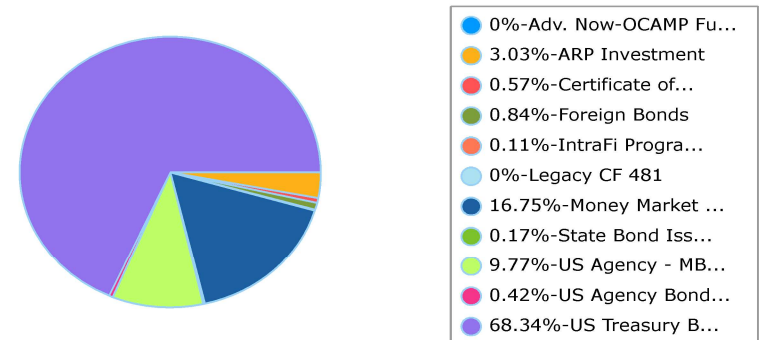

Portfolio Holdings as of 6/30/2026





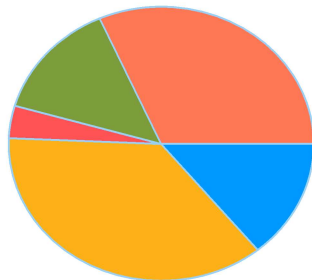

Portfolio Holdings as of 6/30/2026



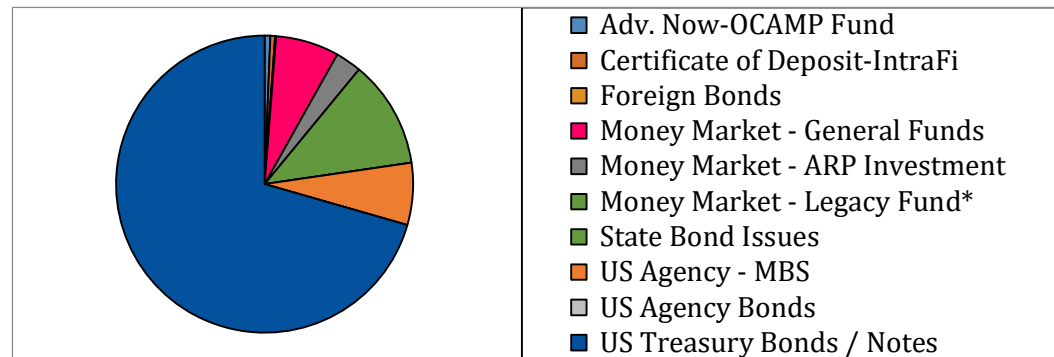

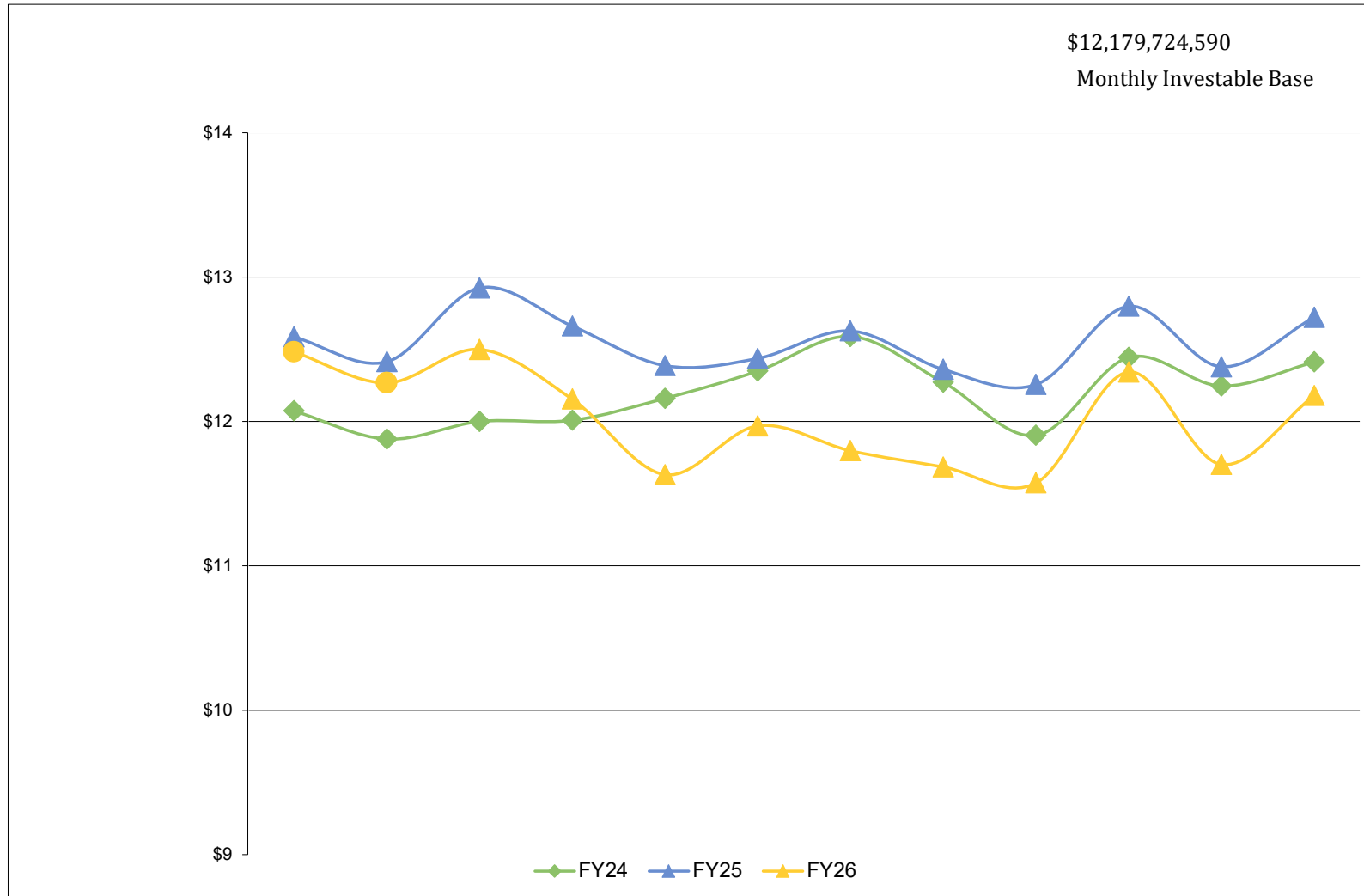

Securities Lending Program

The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Deutsche Bank acting as lending agent. Deutsche Bank retains 15% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the month was \$ 281,310. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains security lending revenue to pay custody and other banking fees in a revolving fund and deposits excess funds to General Revenue.

Northern Trust Custody Fees

Pursuant to custodial contract with Northern Trust Company, custody fees are paid quarterly. Fees to be paid to Northern Trust Company for FY2026 ending June was 75,000.00.
