1. The Service Oklahoma Operator Board meeting was called to order at 3:34 p.m.

3. A motion to approve Apr. 8, 2026, regular meeting minutes was made by Lex Gaylord, seconded by Todd Currie and approved unanimously by the Board.
4. Jay Doyle presented the Service Oklahoma Report.
5. Jay Doyle made a motion to notify Carolyn Henderson, LO #6213 of a hearing for potential action at the next Licensed Operator Board meeting on June 10, 2026. The motion was seconded by Todd Currie and approved unanimously by the Board.
6. Jay Doyle made a motion to approve the relocation application for Valliant Tag, LO #4520, including approval of exemptions for the brick wall, counter, and existing flooring, with all other aspects required to meet brand standards. The motion was seconded by Amber Brock and approved unanimously by the Board.
